


STEP 1: Cut a 36 x 17 cm rectangle out of cardboard.



STEP 2: Without cutting all the way through the cardboard, carve 2 lines, 12cm apart into the cardboard as shown in the illustration. These lines will help later in folding the card.




STEP 3: To make the egg, stencil, print and cut out the egg pattern with the dimensions of 10.5cm tall and 7.5cm wide.




STEP 4: Place the stencil onto the pattern paper and trace an outline of the egg, then cut out the pattern.

STEP 5: Glue the pattern exactly onto the middle middle of the cardboard. (Not Shown at actual size)




STEP 6: Punch holes into the pattern with the help of a needle.

STEP 7: Thread the embroidery needle with 1m of embroidery yearn and make a knot on one end of the thread. Pierce the needle through to the front side of the cardboard.




STEP 8: Stitch over to the back side through the next hole and repeat this step until you reach the other end of the pattern. Similarly stitch the second row as well as shown in the the illustration.




STEP 9: Stitch over the point where the CRYSTALLIZED™ Beads will be attached on the front side of the pattern, stitching under the existing stitches to secure the thread well.

STEP 10: Insert the first CRYSTALLIZED™ Pendant article 6690 then stitch over to the back side and repeat to secure the Pendant. Repeat this step to attach the second Pendant as shown.




STEP 11: Split the embroidery thread into two parts at the back side of the pattern and pierce the needle over to the front side where the next crystal will be attached.




STEP 12: Insert the first CRYSTALLIZED™ Bead article 5000 6mm Pacific Opal and form a loop before you pierce through to the back side. Repeat this step to apply the following CRYSTALLIZED™ Beads:

5000 6mm Aquamarine 5754 6 mm Provence Lavender 5754 8mm Fern Green 5754 6mm Provence Lavender 5000 6mm Pacific Opal 5000 6mm Aquamarine



STEP 13: On the back side of the pattern, tie a knot with the other thread as shown. Secure the leftover thread with four backstitches and cut off the excess.



STEP 14: Cut turquoise and light green ribbons to 8cm length and stick double sided tape on the back of them. Attach the ribbons onto the pattern. Fold the two sides of the card as shown in the illustration.
